Vancouver City and Harbour Tour

Tuesday, May 18th, 8:30am – 12:30pm

Let us take you on a journey that will show you the beauty, history and artistic diversity of Vancouver. The adventure begins with a scenic drive in a deluxe motorcoach through world famous Stanley Park. After an enjoyable visit of the park you will embark a scenic harbour tour providing astonishing views of the historic and panoramic scenery of downtown Vancouver and the North Shore Mountains. Following the harbour cruise your tour continues on to Queen Elizabeth Park, exotic Chinatown and historic Gastown, the city's birthplace. This tour promises a diverse and interesting sampling of the city's sights.



Bowen Island / Howe Sound Excursion

Tuesday, May 18th, 8:30am – 2:30pm

This exciting excursion begins with a deluxe motorcoach drive through Stanley Park and over Vancouver's famous Lions Gate Bridge with spectacular views of the North Shore Mountains and ocean-side Metropolis before arriving in Horseshoe Bay where a ferry will take you on a short ride to the picturesque harbour of Snug Cove on Bowen Island. A guided tour to Killarney Lake to experience the temperate rain forest and West Coast flora and fauna eco-system follows. After a delicious lunch at a popular local restaurant and some shopping in the Village of Bowen Island, it's back on the ferry for a return trip to the hotel.



Gastown, Chinatown and Granville Island Walking Tour

Wednesday, May 19th, 8:30am – 12:30pm

Join one of the best guides in this city to take you on an enjoyable walking tour back in time to Vancouver's origins and the many exciting anecdotes and urban legends. The outing starts with a walk along the city's harbour front to historic Gastown with its quaint cobblestone streets, steam clock and unique shops all housed in turn-of-the-century buildings. From there it's off to exotic Chinatown, the second largest such community in North America where you will visit the Dr. Sun Yat Sen Classical Garden. This is the first Ming Dynasty Garden assembled since the 1500's, and the first one of its kind outside of Mainland China. Your walk will continue towards exciting Yaletown where you board the small, tug boat-like ferry that will take you to Granville Island. This area features a unique collection of converted warehouses dockside restaurants, art galleries and craft works, several theatres and a thriving public market specializing in the choicest gourmet items.. Ample time is provided for strolling, shopping and sampling the delights of the market.



ITS 2010 Companion Tours

North Shore Excursion (including lunch)

Wednesday, May 19th, 8:30am – 2:30pm

This tour will surprise you with the natural beauty of Vancouver's North Shore and spectacular city, mountain and ocean views. A deluxe motorcoach will take you via Stanley Park and the impressive Lions Gate Bridge to the North Shore, winding up the Capilano Canyon to the Capilano Suspension Bridge and Nature Park. When built in 1888 this bridge was the first of its kind spanning 450 feet across and 230 feet above the Capilano River. The Suspension Bridge is surrounded by towering firs and walking trails. Afterwards it's on to the base of Grouse Mountain, where guests ascend by gondola to Grouse's 3,700 foot high vantage point. Enjoy a breathtaking view of Vancouver and the Gulf Islands as you explore the summit. Lunch will be served in an exclusive atmosphere at the peak of the mountain.



Seawall Bike Tour

Thursday, May 20th, 9:30am – 12:30pm

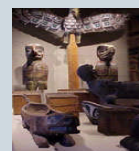
Vancouver is unique in the world in that its downtown is surrounded by a spectacular Seawall which makes a guided bike tour one of the best ways to see the city. Your bike tour begins at the Westin Bayshore Hotel on the banks of the ocean inlet and continues on a leisurely tour around the Stanley Park Seawall with its magnificent views of downtown Vancouver and the North Shore mountains and then past yacht clubs, beaches, housing developments, beautiful English Bay and Yaletown back to your hotel.



Granville Island / Museum of Anthropology

Thursday, May 20th, 9:30am – 1:30pm

This excursion highlights the culture and artistry of the area with a visit to the Museum of Anthropology, located on the campus of the University of British Columbia. A 25 minute motorcoach drive will lead you along the beautiful coastline and beaches of Vancouver. Professional guides will take you on a fascinating walk through the Museum. Afterwards, the tour continues on to trendy Granville Island where you will have ample time to enjoy the unique collection of converted warehouses, dockside restaurants, art galleries, craftworks, several theatres, houseboats and a thriving public market specializing in epicurean delights.



Steveston: Marine Wildlife and Whale Excursion

Thursday, May 20th, 9:00am – 4:30pm

Join us on an exciting adventure and live Western Canada's unique natural beauty. This Whale Watching experience takes you to some of the most diverse wildlife on the Pacific Coast. You will travel by motorcoach to the fishing village of Steveston. Upon arrival guests will have time to stroll through the village before boarding the modern chartered whale watching vessel that will take you through the Gulf of Georgia and the San Juan Islands to see the diverse marine ecosystem of Canada's West Coast. Sightings may include the famous grey whales, bald eagles, sea lions and more.
